## Hotel Reservations:

**Be sure to call the hotel directly for your reservations.** Tell them you are with the B-Girls Reunion Group to get the **discounted rate of \$97 (includes breakfast)**. Do **NOT** make reservations on-line or through the Hyatt 800 reservation line as reservations made in this manner will not put you in the group-reserved block.

Hotel reservations must be made prior to May 5, 2011 to guarantee space and rate. Reservations made after this date will be on a space available basis and the discounted rate will not be guaranteed. Rates will be honored 3 days before and 3 days after.

## TRANSPORTATION:

Midwest Transit System will be providing services for transportation to and from the hotel during the time of the reunion. If you arrive on Wednesday, June 1, 2011 between the time of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. there will be transportation available from the airport to the hotel at \$21 per person. If you are departing from Deerfield on Sunday, June 5, 2011 between the time of 6:00 a.m. and noon then transportation will be available from the hotel to the airport at \$17 per person. These shuttles will run every 60 minutes during this time frame. If your flight arrives anytime other than the times given above then you will need to find your own means of transportation. Taxi shuttle service from the airport to the hotel is approximately \$60.

**Cancellation Refund Policy:** Complete refunds will be sent 30 days before the reunion minus \$17 of the registration fee per person. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GRANTED AFTER May 5, 2011.** Gratuities for the drivers of tours are at the discretion of those on the motor coach. The cutoff date of May 5 is primarily to assure the minimum number for tours. **IT IS NOT A CUTOFF DATE THAT MEANS YOU CAN NO LONGER SIGN UP FOR THE REUNION.** Please be aware that if you decide on-site that you want to take a tour, the cost will be \$5 higher and it will be based on space available on the bus.
